

# Marysville FFA Alumni Judging Invitational

The Marysville FFA Alumni Judging Invitational will be held on March 10, 2012 at Marysville High School. Contests that will be available include: Poultry, Agronomy, Wildlife Management, Nature Interpretation, Meats, Dairy Foods, Equine Management, Dairy Cattle and General Livestock Judging. The Horse, Dairy Cattle and General contests will be off site again this year. Transportation will be provided from the high school to the contest site for Equine ONLY. You must provide transportation from the high school to the fairgrounds for your General Livestock and Dairy Cattle participants!!!

Parking is available in the student parking lot in the front of the school. Please do not park in the "turn around" up against the building. This will be where the contest busses will be and they will need to be able to leave.

Registration will begin at 9:00am and will go until 9:45am. Registration will be located in the sports lobby entrance at the front of the school, adjacent to the main entrance. Only advisors/coaches will be permitted in the registration area. Please make Purchase Orders out to the Marysville FFA Alumni for the Poultry, Agronomy, Wildlife Management, Nature Interpretation, Meats, Dairy Foods, and Equine Management. . For Dairy Cattle and General Livestock, PO's should be made out to Champaign County. **Registration cost is \$7.50 per student. The cost for the meats contest is \$10.00 per member!!!!!!!!**

Food will be available by the registration area courtesy of Barry's from Marysville. Breakfast; including sausage egg and cheese sandwiches and scrambled eggs, candy bars and potato chips and drinks including hot chocolate, coffee, and pop will be available.

The contests will start promptly at 10:00am with all student participants meeting in the big gym. Students will be divided into their contest area and competition will start.
